

## *Training That Enhances Your Council*

ERNLLCA will be offering the following training sessions from May 2011 onwards.

Once again we are very pleased to be able to offer a one-day **Spring Conference**. This year it will take place on Friday, 10th June 2011 at The Hallmark Hotel, North Ferriby.

**Understanding Your Role As A Councillor** - this course will take place during May/June 2011 and is primarily aimed at new Councillors but longer serving Councillors are also welcome if they were unable to take advantage of any previous training. Clerks are welcome to attend if they feel it would be of benefit.

**Meeting Procedure** - this course will take place during July 2011 and is primarily aimed at new Councillors but longer serving Councillors are also welcome if they were unable to take advantage of any previous training. Clerks are welcome to attend if they feel it would be of benefit.

**Role Of The Clerk** - this course will take place during September 2011 and is primarily aimed at Councillors but Clerks are welcome to attend if they feel it would be of benefit.

**Councils Are Employers - What are the councillors responsibilities?** To be delivered during October/November 2011.

**Looking After The Councils Finances - It's Your Responsibility** To be delivered during October/November 2011.

**How Councils Are Led and Chaired** - this will be held in the autumn and will be Part 1 of the National Training Strategy accredited Advanced Chairmanship course.

**Making The Most of Your Role As A Councillor** - this is a 3-part course accredited by the National Training Strategy and on completion of all three sessions, attendees will be issued with a certificate.

**Advanced Chairmanship** - this is now a 4-part course and is accredited by the National Training Strategy. On completion of all four sessions (details of part 1 above), attendees will be issued with a certificate. Councillors who have yet to complete one part of previous Advanced Chairmanship courses are still able to do this and be issued with a certificate.

Information about all the above courses will be sent out to councils and advertised on our website as soon as the details have been finalised.

ERNLLCA will also provide training on the Government's plans for the Power of General Competence when details are published.

Councils who may wish to discuss bespoke in-house training should contact ERNLLCA.

Power of Well Being training for councils will be provided on request although general training sessions will be organised.
